Delinquent Tax Relief Measure Offered Solons

Senate Bill Provides Plan for Easing Burden

BOISE, Jan. 9 (UPI)—Governor C. Ross, who pleaded for relief in his message to the legislature yesterday, will introduce a bill in the Senate to provide for the reduction of delinquent taxes for the years 1924 and 1925 inclusive. In excess of \$100,000,000 is held at the state treasury in installments.

An installment plan is provided which will enable the payment of the delinquent taxes in 10 installments over a period of three years.

The bill follows closely the plan of Governor Ross, who pleaded for relief in his message to the legislature yesterday.

The bill provides for the release of all persons in the state who drive vehicles on public highways, provided they pay \$1 per thousand dollars for ordinance fees for three years for those who claim under the classification of chauffeurs.

Drawn up as a means to reduce the toll from incompetent driving, the bill requires that all drivers must be examined and passed annually by a state board of examiners.

The bill provides for the licensing of all persons in the state who drive vehicles on public highways, provided they pay \$1 per thousand dollars for ordinance fees for three years for those who claim under the classification of chauffeurs.

An installment plan is provided which will enable the payment of the delinquent taxes in 10 installments over a period of three years.

The act further provides that property tax rates may never exceed the county through debts may be reduced by payment of all penalties previous to the issuance of the tax certificate.

S.B. 4 relates to the reading of passenger from the public in schools.

Senate bill introduced the measure, which would prohibit the practice.

Both bills were introduced by members of the committee on the "near future."

FIRST-CLASS COUNTY

Additional arguments why Twin Falls county should again be restored to first-class rating have been advanced as the result of action taken by the Taxpayers' league, endorsing the proposal. When the change was made two years ago by the state legislature, economy was the reason assigned for the move.

It appears that if the present board of county commissioners held strictly to the regime expected of such officers in second class counties, in which classification the county now is, they would be meeting about once every quarter. Bills would lapse, discounts would go uncared for, and the business of the county would flounder. All because of a chance to cut the monthly salary of each commissioner from \$125 to \$75.

It has been shown that by having the county in first-class rating, as it has been for most of the past decade or more, savings approximating \$5000 annually are made by being in position to pay bills monthly and to take discounts. In addition to this, there are many other savings resulting from the county commissioners being on the job more steadily, looking after details and in general keeping interested in their tasks.

The matter of changing the county's classification rests with the legislature, and for the most part with this county's delegation in that body. They are being petitioned for the change by the Taxpayers' league, and it appears that the legislators will be exercising good judgment, and conforming to the wishes of their constituency if they make sure the measure is acted upon favorably at the present session.

NO COMIC OPERA IN WAR

Wars in Latin America are popularly supposed to be comic opera affairs. The memoirs of soldiers of fortune, and innumerable romantic-adventure novels, have sold us on the idea that such campaigns are usually very picturesque, enlivened by the presence of one gold-braided general for every three barefoot privates, but not very bloody.

Recent summaries of the fighting between Bolivia and Paraguay in the Gran Chaco region show that in this case, at least, the popular ideals are wrong.

Latest figures show that fully 40,000 soldiers have been killed in that war; 25,000 Bolivians and 15,000 Paraguayans. When casualties are recorded on that scale—for the populations of the two countries are not large—it is no comic-opera war that is being fought.

It is the real thing; as grim, tragic and bloody, on a small scale, as any war that have ever been fought anywhere.
