Senators Sidetrack Proposal To Ban State Employer for Lawmakers

BOISE, Feb. 6 (U.P.)—President of the University of Idaho was put on the spot by Rep. "Harrison" Clayton, in the house of representatives today. Forty-five members backed Harrison today.

Harrison introduced a resolution which was also signed by Mr. Mary Calhoun, secretary of the budget office, securing from the University of Idaho a list of all the persons or persons to whom all salaries and other expenditures of public funds are made.

"He further resolved, that until such information is furnished, the house of representatives will not consider any bill or bill making any appropriation from the treasury of Idaho," concluded the resolution.

Dodge Given Oath The house passed a resolution today to pay Roy Dodge, so-called tax expert, \$350 for drafting tax measures during the present session, similar resolution was voted down at a stormy session last Friday afternoon.

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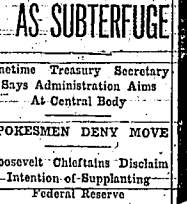
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GLASS ATTACKS NEW BANK BILL AS SUBTERFUGE

Onetime Treasury Secretary Says Administration Aims At Central Body



Spokesmen Deny Move To Establish Federal Reserve

Roosevelt Chiefly Disclaim Intention of Supplanting Federal Reserve

Sen. Charles D. Glass, D. Va., former secretary of treasury, charged today that the administration seeks by subterfuge to supplant the federal reserve system, which he helped create, with a central bank.

Glass' criticism was aimed at the bank bill introduced in congress yesterday, in behalf of the federal reserve bank; the comptroller of currency and the federal reserve board.

P. D. H. Not Sponsor "President Roosevelt sent the bill to chairman of the house and senate banking and currency committee, but it is not a sponsor of the bill."

"Why would the administration want a central bank? Glass was asked.

"I won't attempt to say what is in other men's minds," Glass replied.

Stronger Control "Officially, the administration hopes to consolidate its control over the banking system by creating a central bank."

It is in the United States Administration spokesman deny any purpose to create a central bank upon the federal reserve foundation.

The United Press was informed, however, that for the purpose of the 1933 bank bill is to bring practically all of the country's banks under a central bank.

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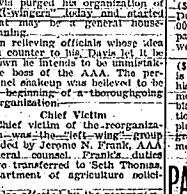

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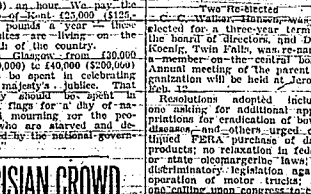
