ECOLAS ADVISES FINANCIERS BACK BANKING REFORM

Federal Reserve Leader Urges Support for Bill Offered By Administration
Greater Powers Over Credit Called Means of Pushing Recovery Pace

COLUMBUS, O., Feb. 12 (AP)—Support of the nation's bankers in the administration's bank reform program was sought today by Franklin D. Roosevelt, governor of the Federal Reserve board, in a speech prepared for delivery before the Ohio Bankers' association.

Ecology urged passage of the new banking bill which he believed was needed to coordinate banking, give the government greater powers over credit and money and to make the reserve system more flexible to guide economic movements.

New "Safe" Effort
The speech was interpreted as a new move by the administration to "sell" its banking program to the nation and to gain banking sentiment throughout the country.

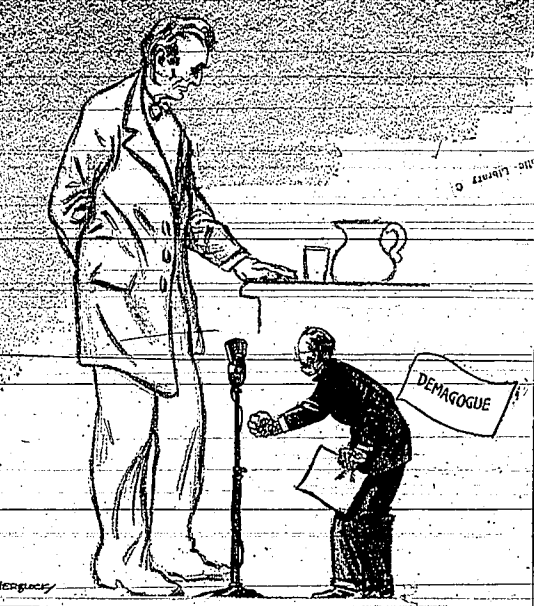
Second, various proposals in the bill are deemed to be in the banking system into closer conformity with modern conditions and more flexible to deal in business recovery.

Third, we seek to make certain fundamental changes in the law relating to deposit insurance and to make it more adequate and more equitable.

Finally, we seek to correct various deficiencies, anomalies and abuses that have developed in the banking system in the course of the past few years.

Since the effect of monetary policy nationwide is the formation of a body which represents the national considerations in the national fundaments of the bank.
