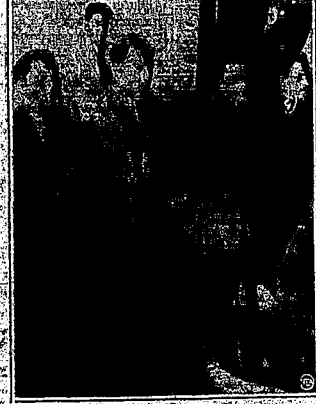



Heavy timber burned in the report said all the heavy timber on the west side of the Haynes canyon road had been consumed and the fire late last night was burning in the foot hill area.

The United Press correspondent at Atlanta, who visited the fire line near Laramie yesterday, reported that more than half the timber in the area destroyed, flames leaping across gullies and canyons at dizzy speed.

Firewarden Wm. Vestendy advised the direction of the flames to prevent destruction of buildings of the St. Paul's Indian mission, the mining settlement of Laramie.
