Every four years the attention of the American-people is jugged to a realization of the fact that their vice nresi

is jogged to a realization of the fact that their vice nresident leads a deplorable life.

He gets a workout during the campaign, and he usually makes the most of it—except in the case of Mr. Garner, who doesn't like to make speeches. A vice president has to make the most of it, for it is the only chance he gets. If his telets is beafen, of course, he retires to private life, and there are no more rear platform talks in his program. And if he wins, his fate is even worse; for he retires then to the lofty and distinguished obscurity of the vice presidency, wherein his compatriots ignore him completely and elernally.






