Clark Urges New Idaho Reclamation Project

LEGISLATORS CONVENE FOR 25TH SESSION

Republicans and Democrats Conduct Caucuses to Pass On Organization Problems Of Idaho House, Senate

(By The Associated Press)

BELGRADE, Dec. 31.—Organization of the House and Senate for the 25th legislative session in the state's history was the principal problem confronting Idaho's two chambers yesterday as they opened into their new seats.

The two will convene here for the 60-day session Monday, the day Governor C. A. Bolton, the state's first Republican chief executive in eight years, is inaugurated.

Twenty-eight right-handers will be in the House and 18 on organization problems and 18 other appointments.

The main question appeared to be the apportionment of 100 representatives, who must be elected from the 92 house members by a majority vote of the house, which will consist of 40 Republicans and 50 Democrats.

Rep. Charles E. Becker, Representative from Ketchum, said he had found the seats because the Democratic minority would give up nothing him.

There were three other outstanding questions: the location of the state capital, the state's new auditor and the appointment of a state attorney general.

Dr. C. B. Scott of Twin Falls Designated Head of Nampa Colony.

EUROPE FACES PERILS WITH PEACE HOPES

Opinions New Year May Settle Ideological Conflict Between Democracies and Dictators of Old World

By The Associated Press

London, Jan. 1.—(UPI)—Europe turned back on a trouble-crowded year which brought more war and greed in 1939 today with hopes that peace may bring new perils already evident.

For the old world it was an ominous New Year which may settle the ideological conflict between democracies and dictators.

Whether that settlement could be achieved without war was a question which troubled millions the world over.

There seemed to be general agreement among European chancelleries that new peace should end 1939 without external wars.

One British official in predicting another critical year said:

"If we can get through 1939 without another major war, we have

NORTHWEST EYES CONGRESS SCENE

Regions' Legislators Lay
Plans for Revision
Campaign

WASHINGTON Dec. 31 (UPI) — Senate Republicans, determined to protect the interests of their constituents by keeping the new year's first plan to a minimum, have advised several vital federal statutes. Their preparations for the new year, however, have been foiled by a more or less united stand on issues striking close to home, with a division not unusual in the Northwest, on the nature of strictly national character.

It was the feeling throughout the Northwest that the bill, introduced by two administration stalwarts, Senators Pope (D-Mash) and McCall, would be amended to reflect the will of the people, but there was a variety of opinion on how the measure should be reflected.

Some members, planning to support the bill, supported among the northwest congressional delegation, were best-pledged

There were also indications from both Democratic and Republican quarters that some move would be made to change the sugar-beet measure recently. The quidnunc announced that the agricultural program brought strong pro-


