BOISE, Feb. 1.—Retail sales of merchandise at less than cost would be prohibited by a bill introduced in the Idaho house of representatives today.

The measure, introduced by the industry committee, was one of 11 presented by the house—only one of which was introduced by the senate.

The act, termed the "unfair sales act," would prohibit the practice of selling certain items of merchandise below cost in order to attract patronage and to injure the competition of the act would be deemed a misdemeanor.
