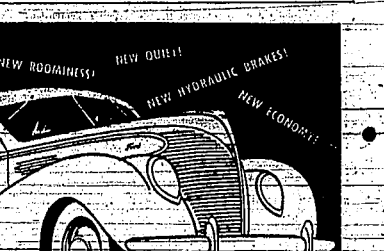

DEMOCRATS EYE RIOT IN RANKS

Congressmen in Conference Air Views on Party Troubles

WASHINGTON, Feb. 14 (AP)—House leaders gathered Democratic congressmen into a meeting today with the intention of infusing into the party a spirit of unity, solidarity and harmony.

These were some of the restful scenes which were presented today by the Democratic congressional campaign committee.

Rep. Dreyer (D-Wa.), chairman of the Democratic congressional campaign committee, recalled to the Elks American committee and concluded it was partly responsible for Democratic failures at the polls last November.

Hard Sheddling Ahead—Dreyer was said to have analyzed the November returns and remarked that they indicated "hard sheddling" ahead.

Rep. Cox (D-Ga.) was quoted as saying that if the present congressional campaign committee "things would be better all around."

Rep. Randolph (D-W.V.) complained that the president should not have slapped house members in the face by asking for another \$150,000,000 for relief before his signature was dry on a bill in which congress had made a real job.

Nevertheless, Speaker Bankhead, Majority Leader Rayburn and some of the lieutenants of the conference as a success. It had been called primarily to persuade Democrats to be on hand for important votes in the house and not to be organized Republicans.

While no votes were in prospect until tomorrow, two hours of the conference had ended 45 Republicans and 42 Democrats were on the house floor to participate on an administration defense bill.

Varying Reports—Many Democrats noted their leaders, however, in insisting that the "strategic" meeting had been a success. Most of the criticisms and complaints, they said, were intended to be constructive rather than caustic.

Rep. Martin (S. Kentucky) (D-Ill.) attacked the party's utter failure and added:

"The only impression I got was that the president had given the leadership a spanking for their failure to deliver the goods—and they were crying on the shoulders of the house members."

It was the second conference of house Democrats in two days that had been called because of concern over the way Republicans had been working together, turning out in full force for major votes, and learning to work with the Democrats.

Members who comprise a transport unit and so-called "blue" boys met last night to make initial plans for helping New Deal legislation through congress.

Congressional Contention—Dreyer was quoted as asserting that contention and lack of cooperation between the legislative and executive branches of the government had contributed to Democratic reverses in the November election and that the purge had caused bitterness and undignified resentment in the hearts of many members.

Randolph's gibe at Mr. Roosevelt's speech in the house on the military appropriation bill followed a speech by Majority Leader Rayburn of Texas. The latter was said to have reported that he told Mr. Roosevelt yesterday that the house decision to vote \$450,000,000 from the \$775,000,000 originally requested for relief was not intended as a rebuff to the chief executive.

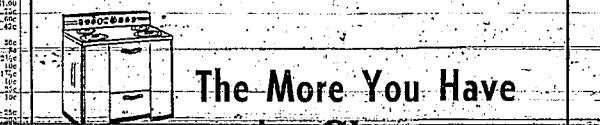

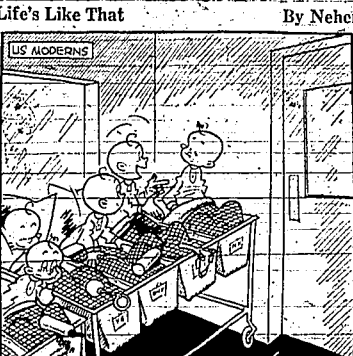
