RUSSIAN FLIERS LAND ON ISLAND

Airmen Forcing Down Near Northeastern Tip of New Brunswick

NEW YORK, April 28 (AP)—Two Russian aviators who had landed in New York tonight after a 4,600-mile non-stop flight from Moscow, were forced down, instead of the island of New Brunswick, Canada, in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

The flight ended abruptly about 7:30 p. m. when the plane, piloted by Soviet Air Hero Brig. Gen. Vladimir Kokotkin and Navigator Mikhail Gordin, was forced down near the northeastern tip of New Brunswick.

The flight apparently was terminated by a motor trouble and the weather which forced them off their course. An hour before the landing, Gen. Gordin said that the flight had been successful.

LEGAL ACTION TAKES IDAHO ROAD SURVEY

Governor Tells Purpose to Provide Adequate Farm-to-Market Thoroughfares In All of State's Counties

(By The Associated Press) BOISE, April 28.—Governor C. A. Bottolfsen said today pending legislation involving the \$1,000,000 farm-to-market road survey bill had postponed organization of a division of public relations in the state department of public works.

"It is our plan, if the 1939 law now under scrutiny is held valid, to make a survey in each county of the farm-to-market requirements," Bottolfsen said.

"If financial conditions warrant, every effort will be made on the basis of this survey, to get adequate roads in that category, as provided in the act," he said.

Hitler Rejects Roosevelt Scheme for World Peace

GERMAN FUERHER CANCELS PACTS WITH BRITAIN, POLAND; OFFERS NON-AGGRESSION PLEDGE TO OTHER NATIONS

BERLIN, April 28.—Adolf Hitler today scrapped his naval treaty with Britain and his non-aggression pact with Poland and thundered a reply to President Roosevelt's peace proposal which sounded the defiance but let the outside world see the door ajar for peace.

He declared to give the guarantee of non-aggression for 13 nations listed by the American president in his April 24 appeals to Hitler and Premier Mussolini, but offered each a non-aggression assurance on the condition of absolute reciprocity provided that the state wishes it and meets addresses to Germany a request for such assurance.

Hitler spoke for two hours and 17 minutes before the Reichstag today, the first time since the outbreak of the war in an open air despite a light but steady rain.

The German government considered the speech as Hitler's official reply to President Roosevelt's appeal for peace. He said that he was not prepared to give an assurance of non-aggression to any one nation, but that he was prepared to give an assurance of non-aggression to all nations.

Resistance To Squeeze Proclaimed

For the most part, however, government leaders who required even more time to digest the speech than the two hours and 17 minutes it took to deliver gave evidence of a feeling that the door was not shut entirely to European settlement.

That was Washington's first reaction but after a study of the speech was over, it contained little to cheer the peace-minded.

Such adjectives as "obstinate," "intransigent," "defiant," and "stubborn" were heard among congressmen. The speech was described as "a masterpiece of propaganda" and "a masterpiece of propaganda."

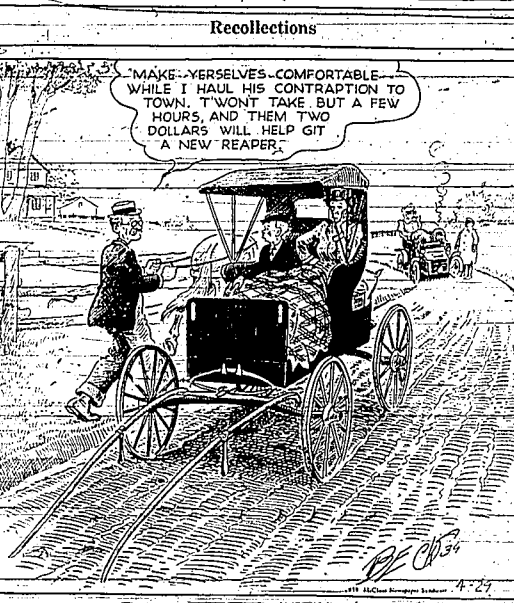

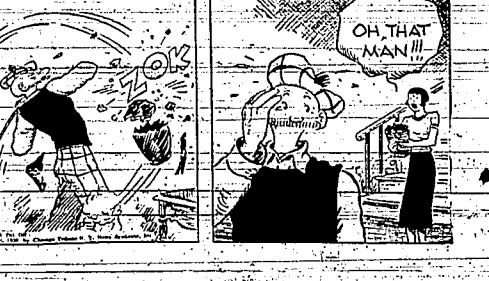

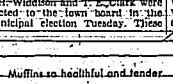
