Brooklyn, July 7 (AP)—Peace-but not quiet—ignited at Ebbets field today while the Brooklyn Dodgers won the largest crowd of the season in Brooklyn, watched their beloved Dodgers beat the Giants, 7 to 2, in the eighth of their red-hot four-game series.

The game was crisscrossed with cops in anticipation of a busy afternoon, but nothing happened to mar the occasion. The local police apparently having been covered by platoons signing warning them that the first spectator to toss a hostile youth to the ground.

Ruling Hits Baseball Lease at Lewiston

Court Orders Injunction in Action Filed by Property Owners Near Park

BOISE, July 7 (AP)—The state supreme court, in a 5-4 decision, today released two orders. One ordered the New Perry county district court to lift its injunction against the Lewiston school district from leasing its baseball park except under certain conditions.

The lease at present is in the Lewiston area in the Pioneer baseball league.

The ruling was in an action brought by the property owners of Lewiston, who requested constitutional provisions prevented the school district from leasing its park to a private concern, and argued also that the playing of night baseball games on the field constituted a nuisance.

The district court ruled against them but the supreme court reversed that decision, maintaining the plaintiffs' contention that "use of the field in the manner in which it has been used herein constitutes a legal nuisance."

The supreme court held, however, that the leasing was not a violation of the school district's constitutional powers.

Justice Raymond L. Olvens wrote the opinion in which the court, with the exception of Justice William H. Meyer, who did not participate, concurred.

The court said Justice Olvens said the school district is not to be prevented from leasing the park to a private concern, but that the lease must be subject to certain conditions, including that the playing of night baseball games on the field constitute a nuisance.
