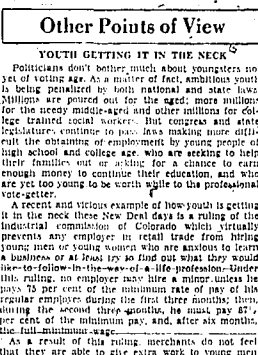

SCHOOLS DISPUTE TAX DUPLICATION

Legislature's Revision of Financial Set-up Leads to Confusion

By EARLE L. JESTER. NOISE, July 27.—(Idaho) public schools get more state funds for their 1939-40 year than the legislature intended.

The situation came about like this: When the state school equalization program was passed in 1933, the legislature provided for the 1933-34 year from the state revenue tax, the nine percent tax, one-half of the net tax and one-fourth of the liquor profits were placed directly in the public school income fund.

The 1932 legislature changed all that. It appropriated \$2,000,000 annually from the general fund to the public school fund and authorized an ad valorem levy on real property to raise the cash.

But that was a false arrangement, especially there was no provision for the payment of taxes for the support of schools.

Had these revenues not been available, the schools would have been likely to anticipate in the building and expenditure of the July 1, 1933, a new year for the school year began. The first collection of the \$1,000,000 ad valorem tax supplied the budget for this fiscal year will begin in December 1933.

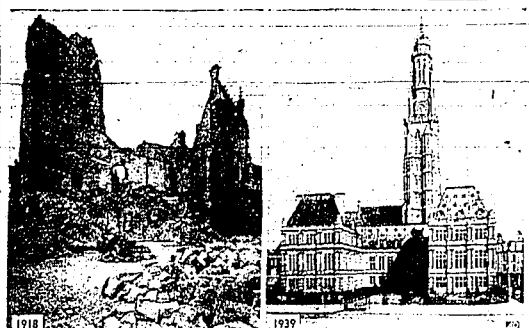

They also contend that they are strategically located geographically. American political tradition has made an east-west presidential and vice presidential ticket a rule which has been followed in every recent election.

The Roosevelt-Garner and Landon-Knox tickets were exceptions. Every indication points to a return of built parties to the east-west political ticket in 1940.

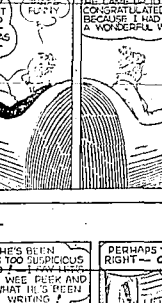

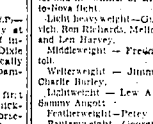
