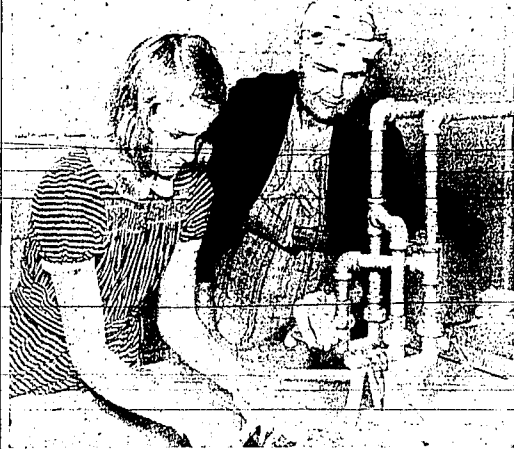

NEW DEPORTATION MEASURE VETOED

Roosevelt Calls Some of Bill's Provisions Too Harsh

WASHINGTON, April 8 (AP)—President Roosevelt today vetoed a bill to broaden the list of offenses for which aliens are deportable, informing congress that it was in part superfluous and in part unjust.

The president said in a message to congress that he had no objection to the first provision, but stated that existing statutes permit deportation of aliens violating certain provisions of the law.

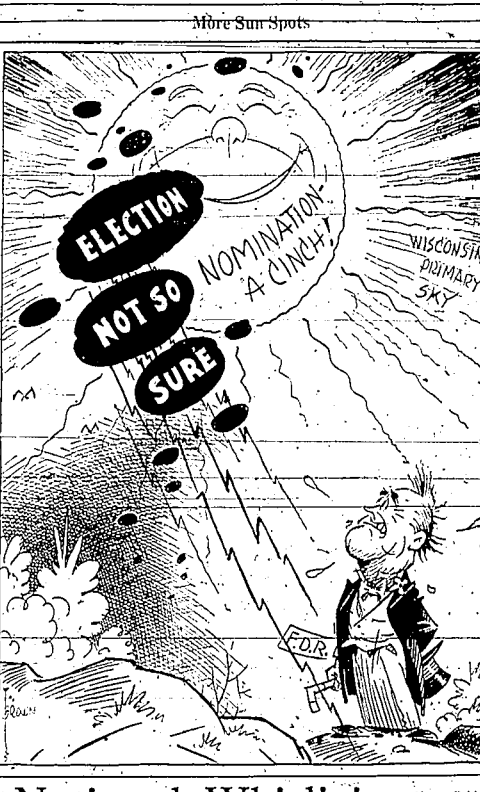

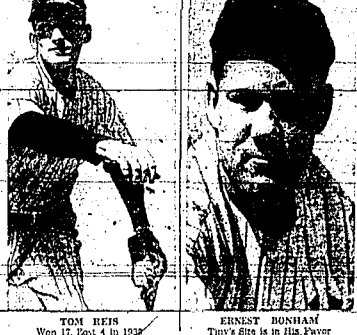
