DEFENSE PLAN

21 Republics Agree on Program to Prevent Transfer of European Possessions in Western Hemisphere

(By The Associated Press)
HAVANA, July 27.—The 21 American republics were in agreement that they would support their foreign ministers tonight on a broad defense and economic plan which an authoritative source described as effective enough both to deter and to discourage any foreign power from casting covetous eyes upon this continent.

The program, embracing the main objectives of the United States, awaited adoption before adjournment of the conference here today, but committee approval was said to insure its success with the collecting nations previously Pan-American gatherings.

This was accomplished through statement of differing viewpoints in committee without materially changing any of the proposals outlined here from Washington by Secretary of State Cordell Hull.

After long hours spent in patient persuasion and argument in a hot room overlooking the harbor, the conference was represented as being gratified at the decision passed.

It was said to be a most aggressive-minded group that hoped and worked for failure of the conference would be shamed and discouraged by the unity and determination shown by the American republics in taking steps to carry out their professions of solidarity and purpose.

At the same time the conference was held by an authoritative spokesman to have shown an awakening of the republics from an attitude of complacency and belief that the United States would protect them from any "black" or "red" turn of events.

Three-Fold Results
The concrete results of the conference as agreed upon by committee were threefold:

1. A declaration that the status of European possessions in this hemisphere is of equal concern to all of the American republics and creation of machinery under which they will be able to coordinate their efforts to prevent any European power from establishing a permanent base in the Western Hemisphere.

2. Agreement on close consultation among the republics in the event of any "black" or "red" activities involving individual governments or the status of a nation.

3. A declaration of the importance of the reported abuse of immunity and privileges by some foreign diplomats and consular agents.

Substituted Word
The formula for dealing with the European possessions was said to be substantially the same as the "collective" strategy proposed by the United States but the word "administration" was understood to have been substituted for "strategy."

HEMISPHERE IN DEFENSE ACCORD
